The Nature School provides a unique learning environment that promotes a student-led philosophy educating the whole child. Students learn through exploration, inquiry, emergent curriculum, and place based education. Teachers observe and record student interests and develop lessons and learning objectives around what inspires them, linking the Ontario Ministry of Education Curriculum to provide a well-rounded education.

Children interact with the natural environment through the use of loose parts, creative play, shelter building, whittling wood, cooking on an open fire, knots, making woodland crafts, and sharing stories. This child-led approach to learning is exploratory, inquiry based, fun and unhurried.

EARLY YEARS CENTRES FOREST SCHOOL PROGRAM

This inquiry-based, two-hour program is specifically designed for Early Years Centers and preschool classes. Children interact with the natural environment through stationed activities that can include loose parts, creative play, shelter building, bug catching, making woodland crafts and sharing stories. Centres are encouraged to attend multiple times a year in order to see the changing seasons.

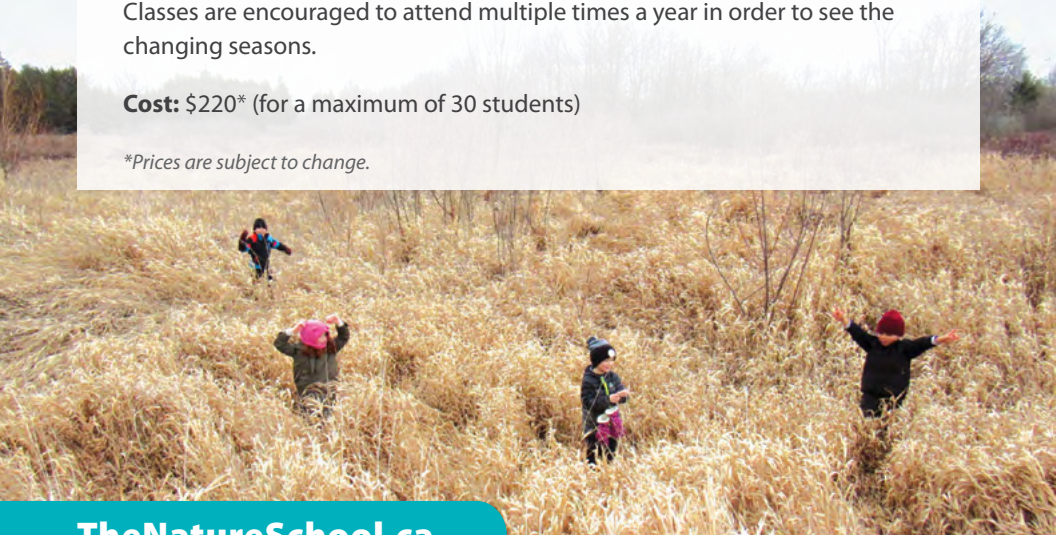
Cost: \$400* (for a maximum of 30 students)

KINDERGARTEN - GRADE 3 FOREST SCHOOL PROGRAM

This two-hour program begins with an adventure in a woodland setting.
